The Alaska Average Weekly Wage (AAWW), determined by the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, and applicable for the period of January 1 through December 31, 2021, is \$1,082.

The maximum compensation rate under AS 23.30.175(a) is 120% of the AAWW, which is \$1,298.

The minimum compensation rate under AS 23.30.175(a) is 22% of the maximum compensation rate, which is \$286.

The maximum compensation rate under AS 23.30.041(k) is 105% of the AAWW, which is \$1,136.
