

**SUBJECT:** Negotiated Common Performance Outcomes for WIA-Youth Programs

**PURPOSE:** To advise WIA-Youth grant recipients of new negotiated performance outcomes for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2011.

### BACKGROUND:

The Department has reached a final agreement with USDOL-ETA for performance outcomes for the WIA-Youth program for SFY 2011. These final negotiated rates are listed below and include an increase in outcomes for the "Placement in Employment or Education" from 50.00 percent to 53.00 percent and the "Attainment of Degree or Certificate" from 60.00 percent to 62.00 percent.

#### Negotiated Performance Outcomes

Placement in Employment or Education	53.00 %
Attainment of a Degree or Certificate	62.00 %
Literacy and Numeracy Gains	33.00 %

### ACTION REQUIRED:

Grant recipients that determine they will not be able to meet the new performance outcomes may request to renegotiate their grant agreements toward outcomes that are achievable. To request renegotiations, grant recipients must contact WIA-Youth Program Coordinator, [Shane Bannarbie](#), at the Division of Business Partnerships within 30 days of the date of this Advisory. Following this 30-day period, grant agreements will be amended to incorporate the new outcomes as listed above, or as otherwise re-negotiated with the Division.
