Electrician Journeyman Certificate of Fitness

[8 AAC 90.160]

An electrician journeyman certificate of fitness authorizes the holder of the certificate to perform work that is subject to the standards of the National Electrical Code established in AS 18.60.580 and 8 AAC 70.025

Application packet must include: Application, fees, Experience verification.

Fees: \$50 non-refundable application fee paid when applying. A separate \$200 certificate fee processed when issued.

8,000 hours of legally obtained work experience in electrical construction or alteration.

A maximum of 2,000 hours may be residential.

A maximum of 1,000 hours classroom training.

A maximum of 1,000 hours of power lineman experience.

A maximum of 4,000 hours of military/vocational experience per 8 AAC 90.890(b).

No maintenance hours will be accepted.

Work performed in Alaska without a valid Electrician Trainee COF will not be counted.

Residential Wireman Certificate of Fitness

[8 AAC 90.164]

A residential wireman certificate of fitness authorizes the holder of the certificate to perform work that is described in 8 AAC 90.900(18). The holder will be considered a trainee level electrician on commercial sites per 8 AAC 90.165(d).

4,000 hours of residential/commercial work.

A maximum of 500 hours of trade-related classroom training.

A maximum of 2,000 hours of military/vocational experience per 8 AAC 90.890(b).

No maintenance hours will be accepted.

Power Lineman Journeyman Certificate of Fitness

[8 AAC 90.162]

A power lineman journeyman certificate of fitness authorizes the holder of the certificate to perform the work that is described in 8 AAC 90.900(17) and subject to the National Electrical Safety Code established in AS 18.60.580 and 8 AAC 70.025. The holder will be considered a trainee level electrician on commercial sites per 8 AAC 90.165(d).

8,000 hours of legally obtained work experience subject to the National Electrical Safety Code.

A maximum of 4,000 hours of military/vocational experience per 8 AAC 90.890(b).

A maximum of 1.000 classroom hours.

Work performed in Alaska without a valid Electrician Trainee COF will not be counted.

TESTING REQUIREMENTS

Plumber Journeyman Certificate of Fitness

[8 AAC 90.130]

A plumber journeyman certificate of fitness authorizes the holder of the certificate to perform work that is subject to the standards established in AS 18.60.705 and 8 AAC 63.010.

8,000 hours of legally obtained work in installation of commercial/residential plumbing.

A maximum of 4,000 hours of military/vocational experience per 8 AAC 90.890(b).

A maximum of 1,000 hours of classroom training.

No maintenance hours will be accepted.

Work performed in Alaska without a valid Plumber Trainee COF will not be counted.

Plumber Gas Certificate of Fitness

[8 AAC 90.135]

A plumber restricted PG certificate of fitness authorizes the holder of the certificate to install fuel and gas piping within property lines of the premises.

4,000 hours of work in the trade.

A minimum of 2,000 hours must be in the installation of fuel gas piping.

May substitute 2,000 hours of commercial/industrial plumbing installation.

A maximum of 2,000 hours of military/vocational experience per 8 AAC 90.890(b).

Up to 500 classroom hours.

No maintenance hours will be accepted.

Work performed in Alaska without a valid Plumber Trainee COF will not be counted.

Plumber Utility Certificate of Fitness

[8 AAC 90.145]

A plumber restricted PU certificate of fitness authorizes the holder of the certificate to install

- (1) water service piping from the street, right-of-way main, water well, or storage tank to the first stop valve of the serviced structure or other point of use or distribution on the serviced property;
- (2) building sewer piping from within two feet of a serviced structure to a public sewer, private sewer, private sewage disposal system, or other point of disposal; and
- (3) building storm drains that receive the discharge of roof drains, leaders, downspouts, or conductors, if the storm drains are installed from within two feet of a commercial structure, or from within two feet of a residential structure of four or more dwelling units, to the street, the right-of-way main line, or a point of disposal approved by the federal, state, or local agency having jurisdiction.

1,000 hours of work in installation of water, sewer, or storm lines.

A maximum of 500 hours of military/vocational experience per 8 AAC 90.890(b).

A maximum of 125 trade-related classroom hours.
