U.S. Census Bureau Releases 2010 Population Data

JUNEAU, Alaska—The U.S. Census Bureau released Alaska's 2010 Census population totals today. These data give population by race and housing information for all geographic areas in the state.

The 2010 Census Redistricting Data Summary includes five tables:

- 1. Total population by race
- 2. Total population that is Hispanic or Latino
- 3. Population age 18 and over, by race
- 4. Population age 18 and over that is Hispanic or Latino
- 5. Total number of housing units and occupancy status.

The redistricting file is used to realign state legislative districts under Public Law 94-171, and it takes into account population shifts since the 2000 Census.
