Autoscheduler Allows Job Seekers Online Access to Training Workshops

JUNEAU, Alaska—A new feature on ALEXsys, Alaska's online job bank, provides easy online access to training workshops offered through the Alaska Job Center Network.

"The Workshop Autoscheduler allows job seekers to view titles, descriptions and schedules for many of the workshops delivered around Alaska," said Paul Dick, director of the Employment Security Division in the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development. "Some of the most popular workshops that job seekers are accessing are Resume Writing, Interviewing Techniques, Alaska Career Ready, and Reemployment Services."

After an account has been created at http://ALEXsys.Alaska.Gov, users can select "Workshops" under the "Job Seeker Services" section to enroll for workshops, which can give them a job search advantage.

"The Workshop Autoscheduler provides the full menu of available workshops," Employment Security Analyst Sandy Burgess said. "Once job seekers select a workshop, ALEXsys sends an email confirmation."

The autoscheduler also allows Job Center staff to schedule workshops to accommodate job seeker demand. Another feature of the Workshop Autoscheduler is the ability to give veterans a preference when they sign up for any of the workshops.
