National Stand-Down to Prevent Falls in Construction

Safety workshops to be held in Anchorage and Juneau

ANCHORAGE, Alaska—The U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration and other federal safety agencies announced that they have designated May 2-6, 2016, for the third annual National Safety Stand-Down. The event is a nationwide effort to remind and educate employers and workers in the construction industry of the serious dangers of falls — the cause of the highest number of deaths in the construction industry.

Alaska has participated in this event since its inception. This year, Alaska Occupational Safety and Health (AKOSH) Consultation and Training will kick off the event with Fall Prevention training sessions in Juneau and Anchorage.
