Board regulation 8 AAC 45.086 provides guidelines to medical and dental providers for required information on a medical provider's report or treatment plan under the Alaska Workers' Compensation Act.

To provide this information, a provider may use a Physician's Report form 07-6102 found at:

https://www.labor.alaska.gov/wc/forms/wc6102.pdf

Medical providers using this, or a similar form, <u>must provide all information required under 8 AAC 45.086</u> to be compliant with the Workers' Compensation Act. As stated in the Official Alaska Workers' Compensation Medical Fee Schedule, "a medical provider may not charge any fee for completing a medical report form or treatment plan required by the Workers' Compensation Division". Medical providers are required to furnish the payer/employer completed reports no later than 14 days after each service. Medical reports or treatment plans lacking the completed information required by regulation are subject to non-payment.

"An employee may not be required to pay a fee or charge for medical treatment or services provided under" the Alaska Workers' Compensation Act. AS 23.30.097(f).
